What Is The Difference Between EuroLine uPVC^{plus} And Ordinary Vinyl?

This is one of our most frequently asked questions. Here's the answer:

By nature, vinyl is a stiff, brittle material that can present several problems for extruders. Some extruders still use homopolymer vinyls that require lubricants, waxes, fillers and plasticizers. Plasticizers make the vinyl more flexible and easier to mould, while fillers make the vinyl less expensive. In time, however, the plasticizers can 'evaporate' from the vinyl or degrade from UV-light. Fillers can easily compromise the quality of the final product. The result is always a lower-quality window.

EuroLine Windows™ utilize uPVC, a new generation of vinyl. The 'u' in uPVC stands for unplasticized, which means that the vinyl contains few, if any, of the plasticizers and materials that can ultimately weaken the window frame. Instead, uPVC uses copolymer vinyls which do not require extensive additives. The addition of impact modifiers and acrylic stabilizers results in a window with amazing strength properties that is able to retain its beauty year after year.
